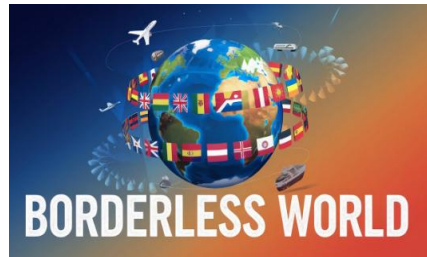


WHAT IF THE WORLD HAD NO BORDERS?
